**INTRALLECT PUTS USERS IN THE PICTURE WITH
NEW SOFTWARE RELEASE**

Intrallect has released the latest version of its world-beating intraLibrary software that allows users to view thumbnail images of content within the learning object repository.

IntraLibrary has already revolutionised the way complex learning objects are stored, shared and reused within schools, colleges and universities.

Learning objects can be any document, presentation, image or packaged content, and the new release of intraLibrary means that users will be able to quickly preview images to determine which are most suitable for their use, reducing the time taken to search.

“We are constantly refining intraLibrary in terms of the way it works and how it can help users and contributors get the most out of their learning objects” said Sarah Currier of Intrallect. “Many educators have large collections of images that they wish to use in teaching: now they can search and preview these easily in intraLibrary”.

Another key feature of intraLibrary is the ability of users to comment on and give a “star rating” to objects created by others. Now users can search for objects based on average star ratings – they will be able to select those learning objects that have been highly rated by their peers – helping them to find and use high quality learning objects suitable for their needs.

Improvements for repository managers include an easy web interface for managing metadata application profiles and vocabularies, and support for different languages.

These enhancements continue to fuel the growth that Intrallect is seeing with intraLibrary, particularly in the schools sector, where intraLibrary is becoming increasingly central to the organisation, sharing and reuse of learning objects.
